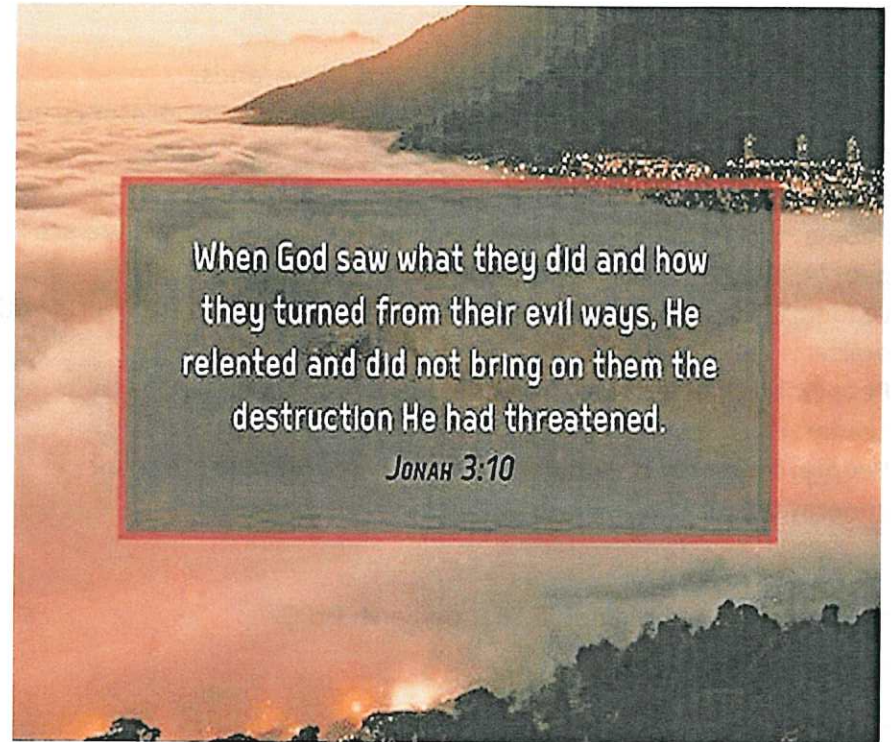

The second Asbury Fellowship Night Out of the year was held on Wednesday at Tully's with over 27 individuals in attendance!

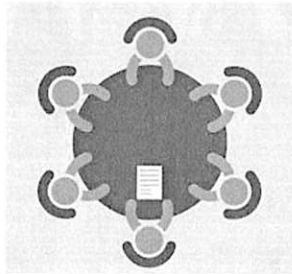

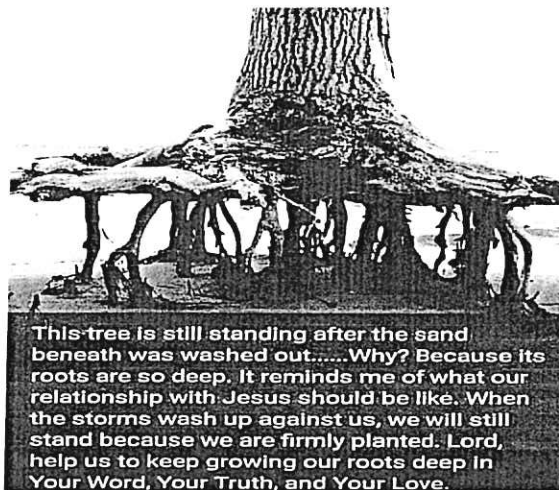
