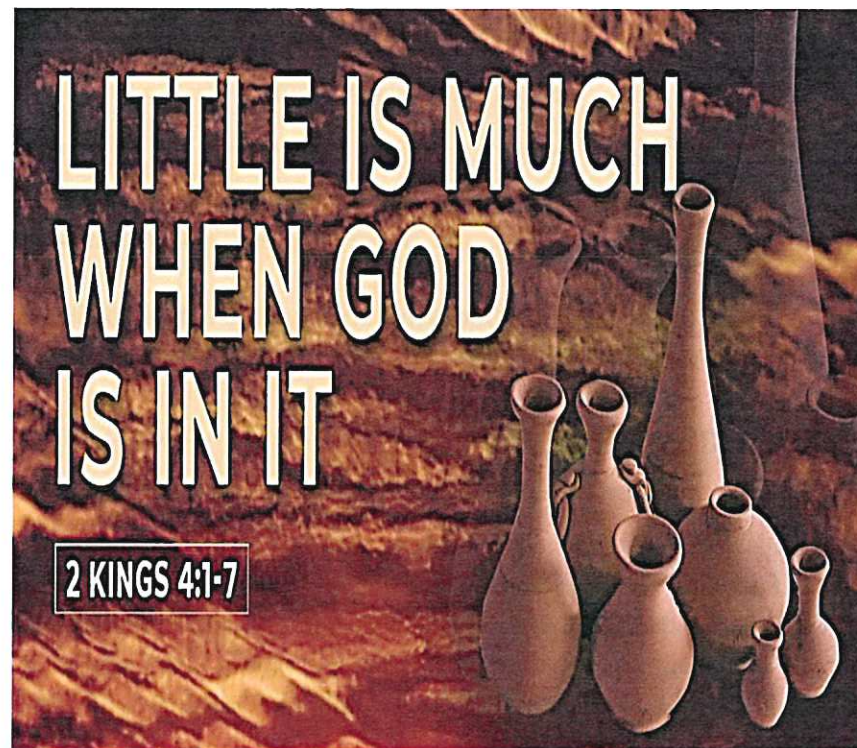

People: We thank you, O God.

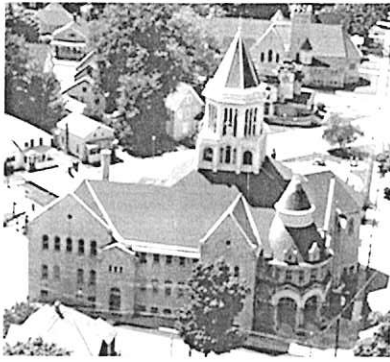
Leader: For all those who come to this place seeking you, and who

Red Bird Mission Trip

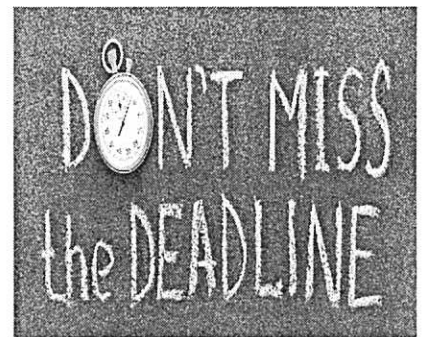
Location: Beverly, Kentucky
