It is our joy to share with you today that Bishop Héctor A. Burgos-Núñez has appointed The Pastor Michael Terrell as the new pastor of our congregation. Pastor Michael will begin his new responsibilities on July 1st of this year. As a United Methodist congregation, we are a part of an itinerant appointment system. Our congregation's staff parish relations committee has met with the district superintendent to identify our congregation's needs and the skills needed in a pastor for our context. We have also met with Pastor Michael to get to know him and to ask questions.



Pastor Michael has been in ministry for 24 years, with 20 of those years as full time. Michael is a Licensed Local Pastor who graduated from Wesley Theological Seminary Course of Study in Washington, D.C. He entered ministry after working in the Broadcast Industry as an on-air radio personality and in TV production.

Michael has a lot of energy and a good sense of humor. Colleagues describe Pastor Michael as a pastor who relates to people of every age group, leads prayer and worship that is real and not sentimental but challenging. People experience the joy of the Spirit at worship with him. Pastor Michael also shows, creativity, courage, confidence and energy.

Comments from parishioners: "more kids attend" - "his spirit is unique and uplifting" - "a pastor that gives an excellent service every week" - "He is real" and "He brought me to this church and my life has changed for the better because of it."

Pastor Michael is very active in the UM connection by serving on Board of Ordained Ministry and as Chairman of the Mohawk District Committee on Ministry. Michael mentors other pastors and teaches Administration at UNY Licensing School. Michael is also a musician and a new children's author! Michael has two children, a dog, a cat and an African Tortoise.

We also want to thank our current pastor, Rev. Laura Calos for her time of service with us and wish her well as she begins a new chapter in her life's journey.

Our new pastor will work with us and the conference so that we continue to nurture disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. Bishop Burgos-Núñez, our district superintendent, and the Upper New York Conference leaders will work with us to continue growing as a congregation.
