FIRE HYDRANT – Out of Service

The fire hydrant on the corner of Franklin and Parker Streets has an "Out of Service" (OOS) bag over it. Several have asked me about it, knowing my involvement in the fire department. I checked with the water department, as it was their decision to cover the hydrant. They indicate that the hydrant is not useable and parts have been ordered for it, however they are difficult to find because of the age of the hydrant. They hope to get parts within a month and work on it as time permits. If the new parts don't fix the problem, a new hydrant will be installed. DON'T WORRY – there are working hydrants on the corner of Parker and Sterling Streets and there are two hydrants on the corner of Clay, Sterling and Parker Streets, so there are adequate hydrants to provide water in case of a fire at Asbury.
