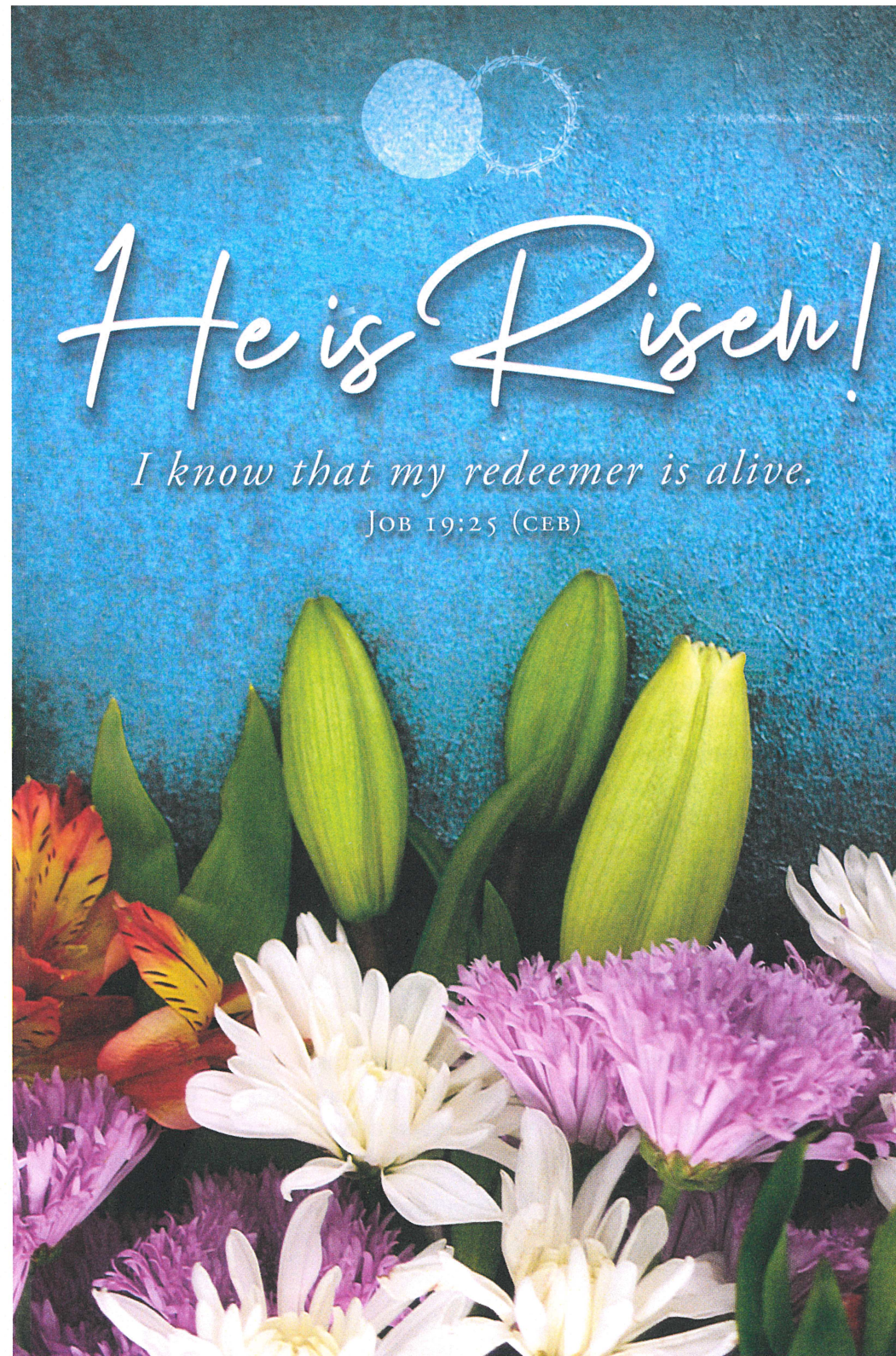

    Of angelic proclamation.

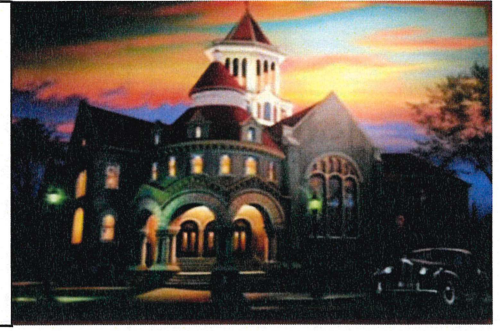
I believe in the God of Easter Day

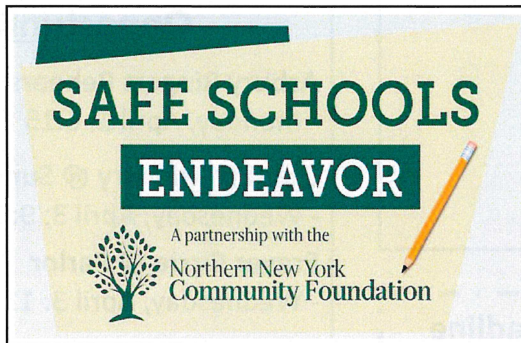

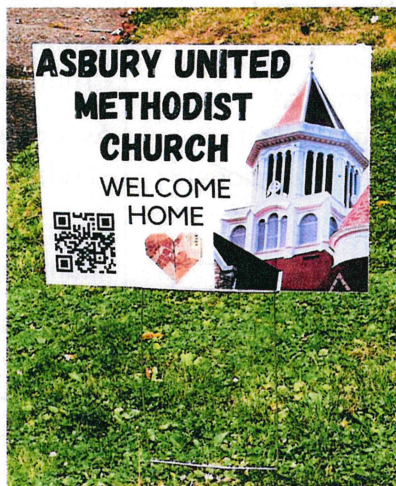
