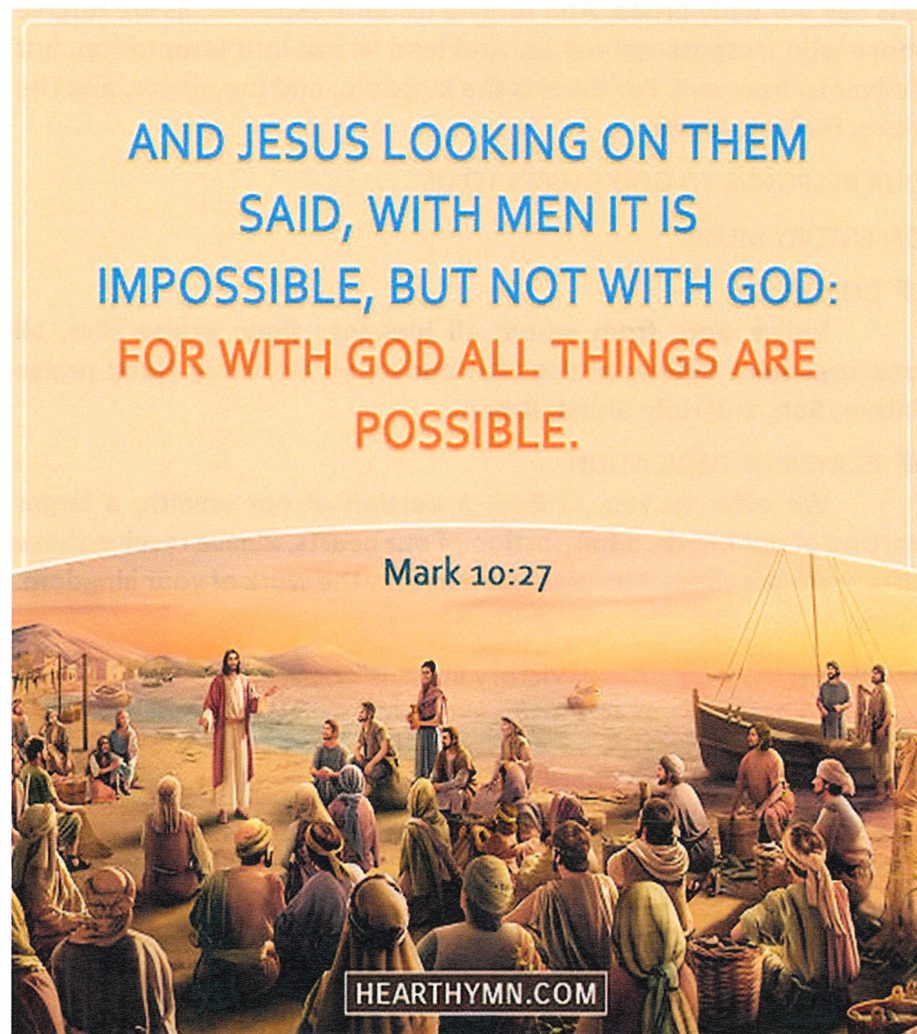

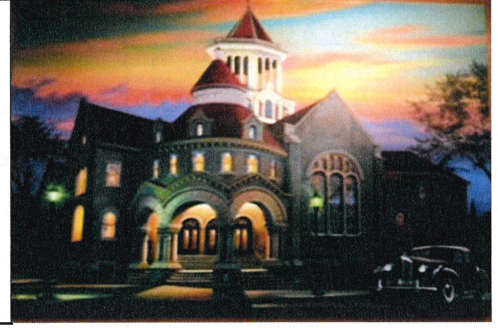

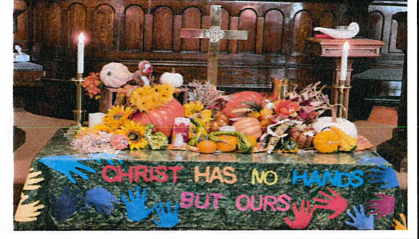

There is also a collection box for donations of candy: individually wrapped fun size plain Hershey bars, packets of Swedish Fish, and Sour Patch Kids.

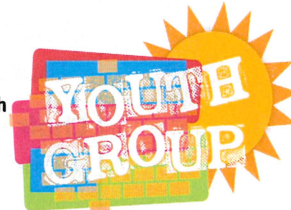
