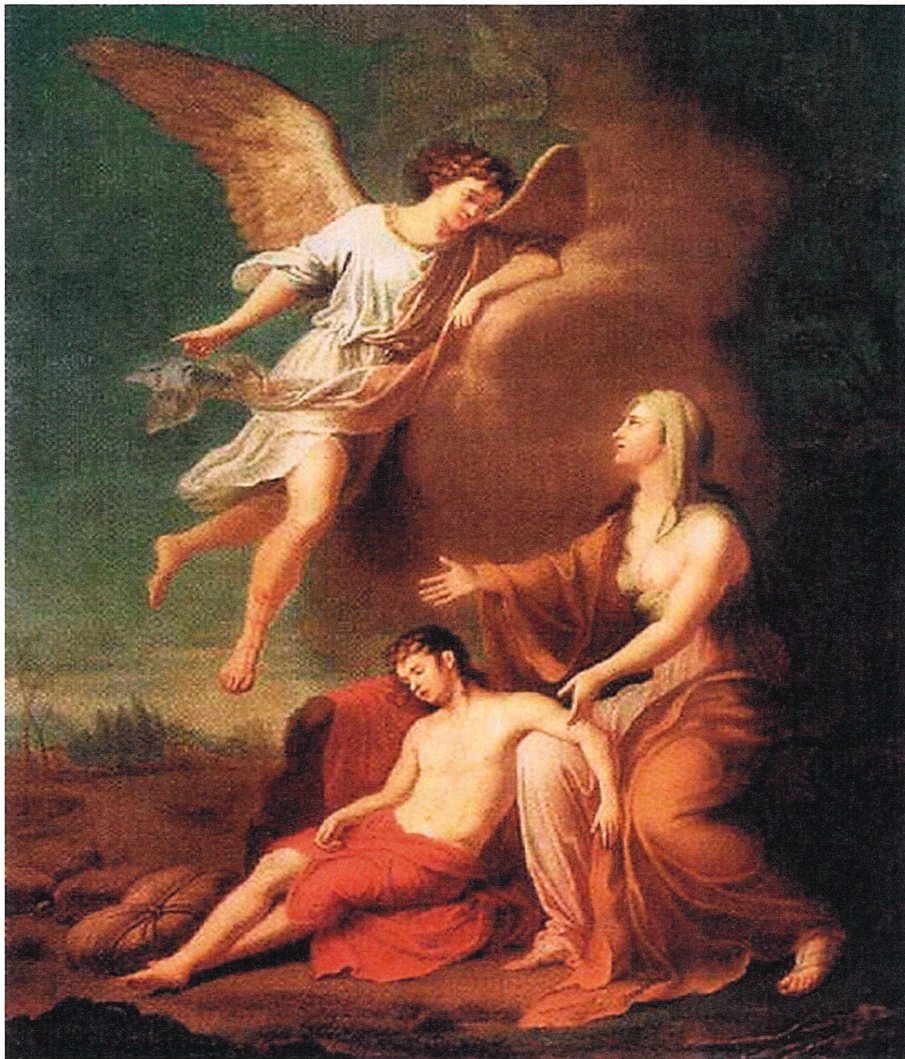

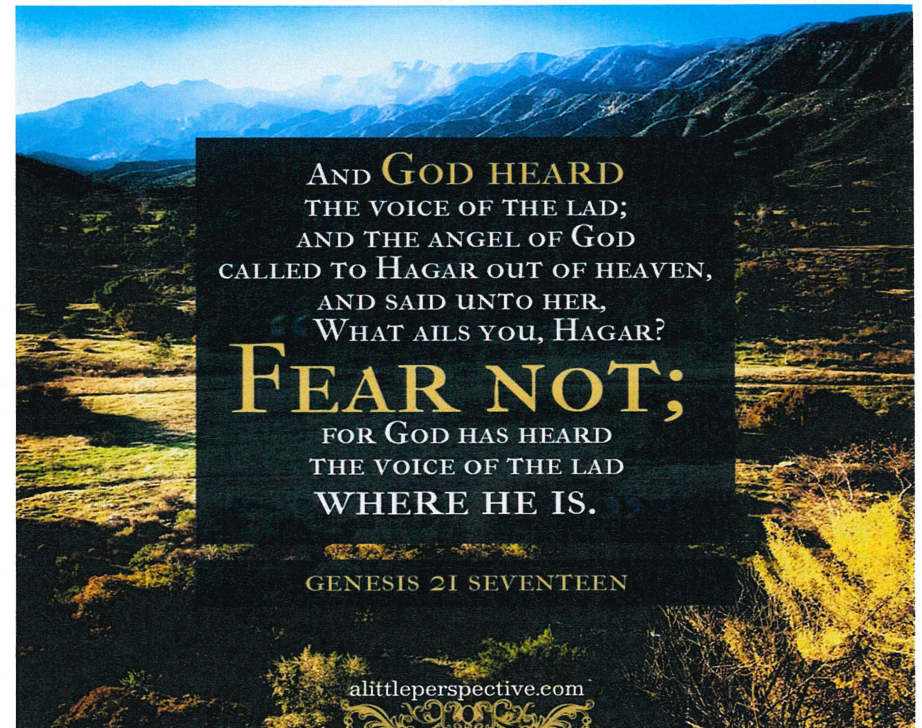

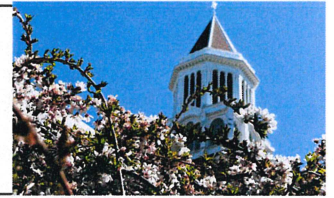

Summer Special Music

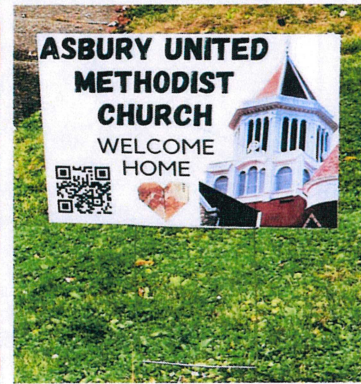
When the Choir is off for the summer, Special Music takes the place of the Anthem in the service. We encourage anyone who would like to play or sing to sign up for a Sunday.

If you want to sign up for a certain week and the Special Music spot is filled, please feel free to take the Offertory spot.

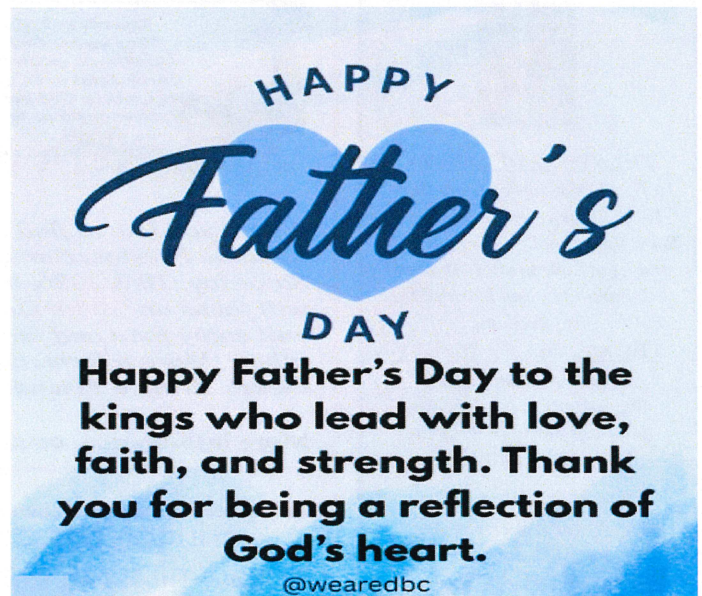
