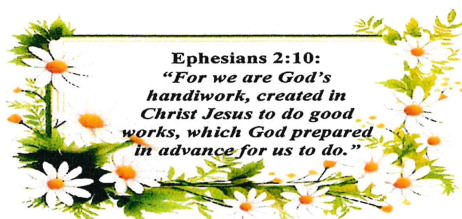
Summer Special Music
